

pH UP Tabex® TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

What is pH Up?

"pH" is a term used to tell how acidic or alkaline a given sample of water is. It essentially ranges from 1 to 14. pH 7 is neutral. pH range for pools is 7.4 to 7.6. If pH is too low, you will experience greater eye irritation, as well as corrosion of pool/spa surfaces and equipment. Using pH Up raises the pH to the appropriate levels, 7.4 to 7.6, which reduces eye irritation to a minimum, as well as prolongs equipment life.



When do I add pH Up?

Test pool water with reliable test kit. Add pH Down if the pH range is below 7.4.

Dosage Rates

Read the directions on the back of the container used. Add the recommended dosage for your size pool

When can I use the pool?

The pool is safe immediately.
